There is a National roster form available on the web site. Please hand carry this to the team check-in, DON'T SEND IT TO ME. This way you can make any additions of deletions, once it is turned in, there is no changes.

Proof of age – be sure you have this available if challenged on the field. Don't need to see it at check in, but you will need to have it available, and no time to run back to the car, or hotel to get it. Any type of proof will be accepted.

There is a mandatory gift exchange during your first pool game. Nothing expensive, just something that could represent your state, or team. Ask the parents to come up with something, as they are great at this.

If you are interested in pin trading, send me an email and I will post the teams that are interested in trading.

The skills contest is set up, so will keep you posted on that. There is a lot to do on that Monday, so be ready.

Games will begin Tuesday, and hope to have the schedule ready on the web site the week before.

Normally the way it works is – you will play one game on Tuesday, and two games on Wednesday or vice verses – two on Tuesday, and one on Wednesday.

Player, and Coaches passes will be handed out at check in – teams are allowed three coaches passes.

Gate admission prices are posted on the web site in the packet. These will also be sold at check in. So, get a list together and make it easier for everyone.
