## NAFA NATIONAL TOURNAMENT RULES –

2009 NAFA rules will govern all play, except as noted herein. (Age as of January 1, 2009)

- 1) Team dress code will be enforced. Coaches will not be allowed on the field unless dressed in appropriate attire.
- 2) Coin flip 30 minutes prior to game time to determine home team, the coin flip will be at a designated area. During pool play, home team will occupy the first base dugout; in bracket play, team listed at top of bracket will occupy the first base dugout.
- 3) Home team will be the official scorekeeper in pool play, and bracket play.
- 4) Line-Up cards are available from the UIC at time of coin flip.
- 5) Tournament softball: Dudley Thunder Heat WTASPFA, Optic, .47 Core – one to each team will be distributed at the coin flip.
- 6) Pre-game conference between managers and umpires will take place at home plate five (5) minutes prior to start of game. If previous game runs long, next game will start ten minutes following completion of previous game. Game time is forfeit time.
- 7) No infield practice before games. Teams may warm up on grass while infield is being prepared. **NO BATTING PRACTICE IS ALLOWED ON FIELDS, OR IN THE COMPLEX AT ANY TIME.**
- 8) Time limit for Pool Play is 1 hour 15 minutes; no time limit in bracket play. Time limits could change in case of tournament interruptions. **GAME CLOCK WILL START 1 MINUTE AFTER PRE-GAME CONFERENCE.**
- 9) Not more than one minute may be used to throw no more than 5 warm-up pitches.
- 10) International tiebreaker is to be used in all games after time limit or 7 innings. In bracket play, international tiebreaker will not be used in semi-finals or championship games.
- 11) Mercy rule: 10 runs after 4 innings; 8 runs after 5 innings; no run rule in Championship game.
- 12) Courtesy Runners – The team at bat may use a CR for the pitcher and/or catcher at any time. The pitcher and catcher are identified as those players who actually were playing those positions at the end of the previous half-inning. In the top of the first inning only, the pitcher and catcher are identified as the players listed as such on the line-up. Neither the pitcher nor the catcher is required to leave the game under this rule. (See Section 6.7 of the current NAFA Rule Book for details).
- 13) Team manager or a coach only may consult with the umpires; players, sponsors, and other coaches are to keep out of the discussions.
- 14) Protest will be settled immediately; members of protest committee are: Tournament Director, Local UIC, NAFA UIC, and NAFA Tournament Representative. Their decision is final

## NAFA NATIONAL TOURNAMENT RULES – 2009 (CONT'D)

- 15) No smoking on field or in dugouts.
- 16) Maximum allowed in dugout is 22, which includes 18 players, 1 head coach, 2 assistant coaches, and 1 bat person. The umpire will ask all unauthorized personnel to leave the dugout.
- 17) No manager nor coach, when on defense or offense, shall sit nor stand outside the dugout (exception: when on offense, two may stand in their respective coaches box). Coaches may sit on a stool at the dugout opening provided stool remains within the dugout.
- 18) Headgear: Visors, headbands and caps are optional parts of the uniform and may be mixed. All headgear must be worn as intended by the manufacturer. Exceptions: Plastic visors, bandannas, and handkerchiefs are not allowable headgear.
- 19) Rolling up sleeves is legal if player's number remains readable.
- 20) There is no penalty if a player's number is listed incorrectly on the line-up card or scorebook if the player's name is correct. Correct the error and resume play.
- 21) Fitness of a field to start a game will be determined by Tournament Director.
- 22) Teams are responsible for verifying the accuracy of game scores as posted on POOL PLAY LEADER BOARD after each game. If you do not agree with what is posted, DO ATTEMPT TO CHANGE IT, NOTIFY THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR AND HE WILL CORRECT IF NEEDED.
- 23) Winner of Pool Play determined by won-loss record. In case of a tie, the following will be used: A:  
Head to Head Competition    B: Fewest runs allowed in pool play    C: Coin Flip
- 24) TOURNAMENT FORMAT: POOL PLAY (3 GAMES) SEEDED INTO DOUBLE ELIMINATION.
